

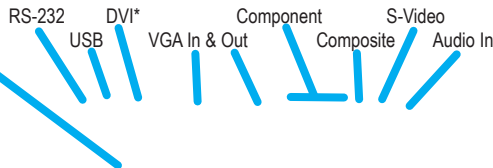
# Quick Start Guide

## BenQ SP870



### Initial Setup

- 1 Turn on your source and flip the power switch on the back of the projector.
- 2 Connect the source to the projector using one of the provided inputs.  
**NOTE:** If you only have an HDMI output on your computer or device, use the enclosed HDMI-to-DVI adapter to connect to the projector via DVI.
- 3 Remove the lens cap and press the power button on top of the projector.
- 4 The projector should auto-detect the source. If you're using a computer, you may need to sync projector & computer by holding down Fn and pressing one of the following keys to toggle:




### Adjusting the Image



- 5
  - 6
  - 7
- 5 Press side buttons to release legs
  - 6 Rotate zoom and focus to reach the size and sharpness you want
  - 7 If needed, change the aspect ratio using the Aspect button on the remote

### Powering Off

- 8 Press POWER button on the top of the projector 
- 9 The power light will change from green to orange
- 10 When the light changes from solid to blinking orange, flip the power switch on the back of the projector and unplug it from the wall.

#### Troubleshooting:

- Does your image look like one of these?



- If so, here's how to fix it:
  - Use the up and down buttons on the top of the projector to adjust the keystone; or
  - Use the up and down buttons on the projector remote to adjust the keystone.
